

262 Hip Hop Crew (ages 10+)

This is an Intermediate/Advanced level Hip Hop program for dancers that have a minimum of 2 years' experience in Hip Hop and are looking to take their skill to the next level. Although auditions are not required, a placement evaluation may be made by attending an open class in advance. Dancers will learn one competitive dance.

Droplets Dance Company (ages 6-9)

Recommended for dancers ages 6-9 years old with at least one year of dance. This program emphasizes learning and retaining choreography, proper ballet and jazz technique, while building a solid foundation in dance. While there are no formal auditions, a trial class is required prior to registering for dancer assessment. The season will run September through June.

Competitive program options:

- Contemporary company (Monday)
- Jazz company (Wednesday)
- Hip hop company (Thursday)

Dancers will learn one competitive dance and compete at 2-3 local competitions.

OUR TRAINING PROGRAMS

There are two training programs available to both Water Street II and Water Street Youth Co. and are based on the number of weekly training hours a dancer or family are able to commit to. Season runs September through June.

Program A

- Required weekly classes:
 - 3 ballet classes
 - 1 contemporary class
 - 1 jazz class
 - 1 additional class - your choice
- Unlimited open classes included
- Hip hop program tuition included (optional)
- 4 company workshops (\$100 per workshop)
- Eligible for 2+ specialty groups (additional cost)
- Eligible for more than 1 solo (one solo required - additional cost)
- Team Conventions: 2 required (one is in-house)
- Team Competitions: 3 required + optional Nationals

 - 2 ballet classes
 - 1 contemporary class
 - 1 jazz class
- Attend extra classes for \$10/drop in rate
- Hip hop program available at reduced price (50% off)
- Eligible for 1 specialty group only (additional cost)
- Eligible for 1 solo only (required - additional cost)
- 4 company workshops (\$100 per workshop)
- Team Conventions: 2 required (one is in-house)
- Team Competitions: 3 required + optional Nationals

Water Street Youth Co. (ages 8+)

Youth Co. is a pre-professional program committed to providing an environment that is not only fun but also engaging, and inspiring. WSDM is committed to fostering and encouraging educational opportunities for every dancer. This includes setting a solid foundation for dance while still providing similar experiences and opportunity in both concert and competitive dance. These dancers are training with the intent that they will progress to the Water Street II program. Placement is by audition only and at the discretion of the Artistic Director. Auditions are held in May, June and July. The annual Water Street Dance Festival serves as the first week of company training for the upcoming season. Dancers accepted into Water Street Youth Co. perform 2-3 competitive group dances and a solo.

Water Street II (ages 12+)

Water Street II is a pre-professional program committed to providing high caliber and diverse technical training. WSDM's goal is to provide our dancers with the foundation necessary to become working professional artists. By committing to our program dancer's will receive experience and opportunities in both concert and competitive dance. Placement is by audition only and at the discretion of the Artistic Director. Auditions are held in May, June and July. The annual Water Street Dance Festival serves as the first week of company training for the upcoming season. Dancers accepted into Water Street II perform 2-3 competitive group dances and a solo.
